highlight of this event was that Ms. Anne Lubell from AusAid has handed over the Funding agreement between AusAid and Mozzies.



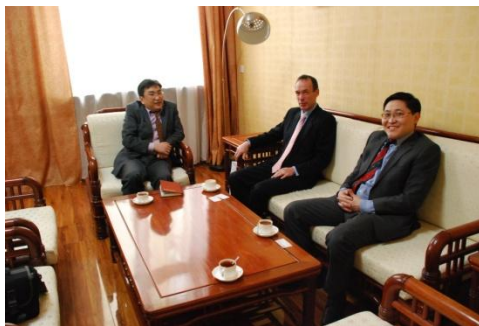

4. **Participation in “Reintegration workshop”.** Mongolia Australia Scholarship Program (MASP) organized reintegration workshop on April 29, 2010 for returning students and employees. The presentation on Mozzies Association has been delivered to participants of this workshop, inviting returning students to join Mozzies Association.
5. **Meeting with AYADs project director.** Anthony Rologas, the AYADs project director visited Mongolia and met with Executive Director of Mozzies Association on April 29, 2010 to discuss about the AYADs program and to continuing the strong partnership between the Mozzies and the AYAD Program in Mongolia.
6. **Trivia night - 2010.** The social activities committee of Mozzies Association initiated and organized trivia night event together with AYADs on May 1, 2010. The event was actively organized by Lut-Ochir and Emma Browne and students of English language course were actively involved in this.
